

ife has many uncertainties and sudden twists and turns—some for the better, others for the worst. There is a book that I have read numerous times over and over again. Each time I gain new insight and learn new things that I have missed out on in the past. This book is the words of God, the Holy Bible. All of these are by God's mercy and loving grace!

After spending the past 20 years with Usana Health Sciences and having been trained by numerous world-renowned nutritionists, I have learned so much about healthy living. Be Healthy to be Happy

To eat properly, sleep well, and wake up naturally is what I termed good health. If I were to go on with my daily hygiene without someone helping, that is the best physical welfare. I might have visits with my doctor for some physical check-ups, but not for any operation or surgery.

Every organ in our body is essential. The heart is the engine of the body. It drives the whole body system. When the heart stops working, then the person is dead.

When someone desires to show his affection to another, he would say, I love you with all my heart, or I am giving my heart to you. On Valentine's day, we use a heart to symbolize love. The whole heart represents unconditional and complete love. When someone does a good deed, we would comment: Oh, you have a "good heart." The opposite is to say, "Oh my, you are a 'black-hearted' person!" Thus, we see so many symbols of hearts around to represent love.

There is another symbol wherein an arrow has pierced through two hearts together. It is the arrow that unites the two souls. When the courtship is successful, we comment the couple as (simsim-siang-ai in Amoy, 心心相愛). Two hearts are chained together to represent their cooperative effort, chaining them into the oneness of heart and mind. People falling in love with each other are called sweethearts. If ever this courtship was not successful, we call the situation 'broken-hearted. There is a saying. Two is a good company, 3 is a crowd; some would rather be a wonderful one!

Come to think of how a person with only one heart shares his heart with multiple lovers. What kind of love is it? Is it for money? Is it for sex or what? How can a heart be broken into pieces so many persons can share?

Rose is the most popular flower in the world. Roses come in many colors, and all roses have thorns. Some roses can even change color. But

a man may bring a bouquet of roses to express his love when he visits his girlfriend. Why?

In my opinion, the colors represent the kind of love: Part-time love, artificial love, leftover love, or complete love. All roses have thorns; which one you are willing to bleed for. In the desert, a cactus may be better than a rose.

How to take care of our hearts?

We should have a proper diet, instead of eating just anything we want. Not too much salt, sugar, or oily stuff. Everything in moderate proportion. Take the example of a car. One would use premium gasoline to make it runs well. We have only one heart, and we better take good care of it!

We need to have enough hours of sleep. Each person needs 7.5 hours to be healthy. There are times when I have only slept about a little over 6 hours, and I feel I am wide awake and would be ready to do my task. But then, I ask myself, to wake and rush into my work, what is the basis for me doing this? Why not lie down for another one and a half hour—so I could get around 7.5 hours of sleep? I learned this from my good friend, who never naps. Denis is in his eighties.

We need to do some physical exercises. We could either play golf or ride a bike around. If we have a garden, we could do some gardening work. We could also do some tai-chi exercise in our backyard or do a few physical activities to loosen the bones and train our bodies' muscles. By so doing, it would also improve blood circulation and make us feel much better.

Another subject that we may have to discuss. Do we need to smoke or not? To smoke cigarettes is allowing our lungs to roast over the blazing fire. When we take an X-ray on our lungs, we could see that our lungs are dark and black.

Let me share with you a true story. My father-inlaw was the vice-president in charge of marketing for a prominent and well-known cigarette company. He needed to know the difference between their company's brands and those of the competitors. Therefore he must try each of the different products.

On a routine physical check-up, his doctor told him, "From now on, you do not have to come to see me." My father-in-law asked in surprise: "Why, how come? The doctor replied: "If you would not quit smoking, then you do not need to see me anymore." Then the doctor showed him the x-ray result of his lung, all dark and black!

When my father-in-law returned home that very day, he threw away all the cigarettes he had. Imagine, as the vice president of this company in charge of its marketing and sales, it was a tough decision for him to make.

Ramon is my wife's younger cousin. When he was working in my record production company, he smoked quite a lot. Whenever we talked, I would inquire, "Have you quit smoking, Ramon?" He would reply, saying, "It has been so many years that I have been smoking, Victor. Do not worry. It has been my pastime enjoyment." Sometime after his retirement, I received this phone call from a relative, telling me Ramon has incurred lung cancer, and there was no more cure!

There is another relative. His wife would constantly nag him for smoking at home, so he would then smoke outside his home.

People enjoy smoking, which is why some call these cigarettes fragrant cigarettes 香煙. But for the non-smoker, it's a foul stinky odor!

To describe how a lung cancer patient feels is likened to have one's whole head submerged down to a pool of waters without being able to get out. How painful this situation could be. Why should one choose to undergo such suffering? Why not merely quit? Oh, yes, I know it is so hard to stop smoking. But it is even harder to suffer and die!

Another element that causes illness is the stress we face in life. With so many unsolvable problems and challenges, we could be unable to breathe well too. As we continue to live such a driven and pressured life, our time would run out.

Many thought that a wealthy person does not have stress and problems. It is only the poor. But the truth is not about being rich or poor; we all have issues of our own. So I decided to invite Joe to lunch. Without any hesitation, Joe, the commissioner, made time to have lunch together with me. After lunch, Commissioner Joe & I paid a short visit to the guy's office to say hello. Afterward, all the annoying phone calls stopped instantly.

Thoughts on True Freedom

Immigration

In almost every country that one has thought of migrating, the immigration officers would ask this question: "Why do you decide to migrate?" You may

reply, "Canada is so beautiful. Canada is a place for my future!"

For me, I have never been to Canada before, but merely relying on what some people telling me that it is a great place to call home.

Canadian immigration uses the point system. Canada counts the total number of credits, such as our educational level, business experiences & financial ability. With a passing mark, the applicant could readily get accepted. In 1978, when immigration was relatively swift and easy, we applied.

Nowadays, the immigration application is stricter and more demanding. One has to wait for what type of opening is available.

Migration is uprooting one's home to a new & strange place. One would need to expect big-time lifestyle adjustment.

Skilled workers immigration: The skilled worker category of immigration to Canada is a popular visa program. And it is intended for people with high levels of skills and experience.

Business immigration (business owner): The business immigration category allows immigrants with sufficient business experience or management experience to receive a permanent residency visa in a shorter period than other immigration types. It aims to attract talented investors, entrepreneurs, and self-employed individuals from outside Canada to improve the Canadian economy and access foreign markets.

Family class immigration to Canada: The family immigration class allows Canadian citizens and permanent residents to sponsor close family members living abroad to immigrate to Canada, including finding a job in Canada. This category often requires a job offer from a Canadian company.

My Seven Suggestions to Consider Before Migration:

- 1. Ask yourself, why move?
- 2. Are you ready & willing to adjust your lifestyle, do the cooking, do laundry, do vacuum, and all housework by yourself?

- 3. Are you determined to stay as a family & face unexpected challenges together as a family?
- 4. Job & Security. Got some extra money in case your plan did not work out?
- 5. Self Independent. Such as driving, etc.
- 6. Be sure to consult a Canadian Immigration officer or lawyer for advice.
- 7. Place of worship. Pray. God is good. God is love! God cares! God is in control. God will take care of you & your needs.

Talking about worshipping, you need to find the church to go to for religious activities and worship service. Do some searching. Ask your pastors.

It is always best to be prepared and never think of relying on friends or relatives. No one is still actually reliable and dependable. It could be very dangerous.

When you encounter problems, you may suffer much. Friends may not deliberately nor purposely take advantage of you, but there could be room for such sad things to happen because you are a new kid in town.

For instance, your friend might get envious of you. Some may even try to cheat you out of your money. You must be careful not to fall into such a devious trap.

There are cases wherein the earlier migrants have invested in some business endeavor and are on the verge of bankruptcy & needing more funds. Seeing that you have just landed, they may coerce you into joining their business venture. If you were to refuse their proposal, they would be mad at you. Imagine you just sold all your assets in the Philippines and would like to start a new life in a new country, but then all your savings got squandered. Many such things are happening. Be careful.

DIY Theory

Many people migrated without learning how to drive. The new country is spacious and expansive. You could take public transportation, but this may not be too convenient. To ride with other friends would cause you to be dependent on their schedule and their willingness to help. Do not dream by just calling a friend who would immediately come to your service. The situation is not comfortable.

Everything has a price tag. Do not be so naive. Many have come with bright hopes for better opportunities. Yet, so suddenly, they could be bogged down with despair and burdened with broken dreams and shattered souls. What more, if your financial situation is not as favorable as you have envisioned, then your peace of mind would be affected. When all these unexpected troubles and unprepared trials set in, you would be feeling so lonely and hopeless. Thus, it is a severe matter to ask yourself first: Why do you want to migrate to a strange place?

Whole Family Migration

This type of migration is the whole family moves together into another country. When this occurs, it is like pulling out your entire family roots from your origin into an unfamiliar and new place that is foreign to you and your family.

In the Philippines, you may have your housemaids and drivers to serve your daily need. Your housemaid would put different good dishes on the table and even complain and murmur about the foods she prepared for you. Upon your order, your maid will bring your water before you. There in the new place, no water would come when you call. You have to boil your water and fry your eggs, prepare your food, all by yourself. You need to learn to live and work without any house helper to attend to all your necessities. You then recall how life has been so good & easy back in the Philippines.

When illness arises in your family, what should you do? You may call 911. This 911 number is for an emergency. It responds to the most crisis, including someone who is about to jump out of the window to commit suicide. When someone is on the verge of dying, 911 would respond to the call. Whenever there is a car accident, 911 would attend to the need too. However, if someone simply mistakenly called 911, There would be fined.

What I am stressing here is that everyone is busy with his matters. You could not rely on anybody except yourself.

When you are lonely, it would be better to have a church group to connect with you. Again, let me warn you that the church group is also humankind. Everyone has his limitation to help. Not everyone has the time to attend to your needs.

God is our only refuge. God is dependable at all times. Some new immigrants could be seriously thinking of getting into a new business. Be careful, be observant. Who is the person that is inviting you?

Final Decision to be Made

Not all migration has a positive outcome. Some people experience a better life after migration; others would choose to return to their home country. Migration is not a one-fit-all solution to a prosperous life abroad. Many have lost so much effort, money, and time in the new place and come home emptyhanded. Moving one's permanent residence to a faraway country entailed a lot of unexpected hurdles and unthinkable hindrances.

Lifestyle abroad is different from home. Even business enterprises have a lot of other systems causing much frustration. Suppose one were to study and interview those who have gone abroad and returned home for good. During my time, those who have left for abroad and those who later return home have a 9 to 1. I stay on because I was determined to stay put.

I have witnessed people who arrived and lost everything they have labored and saved because they listened to the wrong people who pretend to be assisting the new immigrants.

People could lose their money, their spouse, their properties, and everything in the name of finding a greener pasture. Many evil-minded persons are pretending to be angels that deceive the weaker ones. If you migrate as a couple, remember to cooperate and complement each other in every aspect of life. Stay together. Hold on to your commitment to love & provide willingly extra understanding to face all the challenges together.

Do not insist when your inner promptings dictate against your decision. Save yourself from imminent suffering and pain. Never compare against each other nor blame any fault upon each other. Be careful and watchful for each other's sake. Any fight or argument leaves room for the enemy to break your marriage, hurt your bank account, and annihilate you.

Remember, no one forces you to migrate. It is purely your own. Thus, do not complain and blame the government when you encounter difficulties.

Let's Talk, but Listen First

Communication is social interaction. There is the so-called "art of expression." At the very start of communicating, if someone is fuming mad and talking simultaneously, this will break down communication. The mood expressed is a fighting mode, causing quarrels and divisions. Thus, our expression during transmission is so essential.

If we were in a bad mood, we might not be able to say what we meant. It is our lousy mood that takes control of what we say. Better to wait for a better time when we are calm and more relax to talk things over. We all need to learn the art of communication.

Secondly, we need to watch the words we use in conversation. A statement may be illicit, both a positive and a negative meaning. It is due to the tone of voice from the one saying it. Thus, our choice of words and tone of voice are crucial and vital in good communication.

Our facial expression is also central to match the words we utter. Try saying some lovely comments with an angry and ugly face, such as: "I love you!" The other person may be confused and wondered if you meant that you love her, or are you thinking of killing her.

Do we understand what the speaker is saying? Do we get the correct meaning of what the speaker is trying to convey? At times, we might misunderstand the speaker's meaning and take his words negatively.

The proper and more effective way of communication is to sit down and talk patiently with one another. Listen carefully and keep calm as we converse with the right attitude & right choice of words.

When we speak with our family members, respect that they are human beings, just like ourselves, with feeling, avoid hurting and insulting them. Some people are so used to their self-promoting style. They would keep repeating statements such as: "I am so good; I know what I am doing." "I am always right." We can agree or disagree, but we do not have to react.

There are times we may meet someone gifted, and they are so humble. And some turned out to be silly and senseless in their demeanor. It is normal.

When we try to solve an issue, remember to focus on the topic we are trying to solve. We mustn't criticize nor attack anyone. Words such as how stupid you can't solve the issue are not the issue.

It is mainly seen at home when a parent rebukes a child with derogatory words and manners. Some parents would shout at their child, saying: "You are so 壞死 (Huai si); meant terrible death." It is a curse more than a scolding! Does the parent want the child to die a terrible death? Of course not! 好人好死;壞人壞死 (hao ren hao si; Huai ren Huai si). It means that a good guy would have a good death and a bad guy a nasty end.

The choice of words in a conversation plays a significant role in human communication. In a family, the right choice of words can solve a problem, while the wrong choice can expand it. That is why the Bible advises us to listen more and speak less.

In life, there is so much we need to learn, and we must keep on learning. We learn by listening. When is the right time to talk then?

For example, when we see newcomers in church, we should greet them. We need to stand in their shoes and feel how they are feeling. Perhaps they are carrying a heavy burden in their hearts and needing some help. Do not turn them away with our silence. It is time to start talking first & listen later.

What I am saying here is our expression in communication is essential to every interaction. Always be attentive to the art of presentation and enjoy wholesome and fruitful communication wherever we go.

Every morning, I would take the Garlic Mix. It is a drink that Annette put in so much time & effort to prepare for me. So that morning, I placed my glass of garlic mix in the microwave to warm up. As I was about to take the drink out from the microwave, I accidentally tipped to the side and toppled. The drink spilled out inside the microwave and tumbled out on the table that the microwave was seated. I had two choices. Wipe the table and be late or just leave the table alone and go to church.

After praying and ready to drive, Annette noticed that there's a hole in her stocking. Being a perfectionist and in all matters, especially in fashion, she never would allow herself to leave the house with a run in her pantyhose. This time, she rushed back into our room and picked a new pair of stockings, and remarked: "Let's go." So we went.

As we pulled into the parking lot, we found out that we still have about 10-min before the service start. Annette was able to change her stockings. Praise The Lord.

At times we would encounter hindrances beyond our understanding. In many situations, we have questions. We could not be sure of its outcome. But let us remind one another that we are confident that God knows what is in our hearts and what we need. He will carry us through these hindrances. We just need to have our God walking in our midst.

The weapon of destruction

The enemy would use many means & tactics to destroy our relationship with God. The weapon of

destruction could simply be a petty argument on a very irrelevant matter among God's people. There are times, even as we get ready to go to church, we could find ourselves under the enemy attack to block us from going or late of going.

It has kept me thinking about myself going to the church to worship if Jesus were to be standing in front of the pews, waiting for me to arrive, how horrible & disrespectful I would feel! Lord, please forgive me. Please help me remove this bad habit of being late out of our routine.

There are times when Annette and I both try to leave home earlier so as not to be late for church. While we were already inside the car, I found out that I did not bring my eyeglasses. I went back into the house, look for it. I lost 15 min. and we are late again.

To avoid being late at church, I would drop whatever I was doing & prepare to go to bed earlier the night before.

I use a C-pap machine & humidifier that needs to sanitize every night, plus the other pre-bedtime things to do, including our time for prayer, would total to almost an hour to do. So I would start an hour earlier.

In our world today, time is precious—no time for God. God wants to answer our prayers, yet we do not have time to listen. I ponder, is God who doesn't answer our prayer, or is it we ignore God's reply?

We have time to watch a movie. We have time to talk with friends, but we have no time for God.

Lately, I found it more interesting to slow down my pace in reading the Bible. I immerse myself in God's Word, sentence by sentence. I could see the difference it does to my soul and spirit. It broadens my understanding as well as deepens my insight from God's Word.

And many times, they risk the lives of their patients.

How can you trust a foot specialist to operate your brain? Be sure to find out if the doctor is a licensed bona fide medical doctor.

As I stand beside and see all these happenings around me, it makes me wonder how these quacks could account for themselves one day before God.

I have also seen situations wherein you consulted two very professional and able physicians. One informs you that you have contracted cancer, but the other says you have no cancer sign. Both are cancer specialists. Now, which of them should you believe? It calls for a medical lab test. Do not just consider what you select to think and go home crying and be so depressed by the info you get.

Lately, due to my elderly age, I have started to watch my health more carefully. I bought a blood pressure monitor to gauge my blood pressure. As I pressed the monitor as directed, I pushed again after a minute, and I waited another minute to press. I got three different readings. How then should I interpret my result?

There are times when I find myself in my doctor's clinic, and I would also try to test their machine or monitor. After the nurse has read my blood pressure, I would request her to do it again immediately for the second try and even the third time. Amusingly, all the results of the three readings are different.
